Subject: Clarification of "MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL"

In the CCAGP BY-LAWS, under ARTICLE II, one of the purposes of CCAGP is "to sustain and maintain THE MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL." This memo is to clarify what is "THE MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL".

History: THE MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL was first formed in 1961. In 1970, it adopted the school name: "The Chinese School of the Greater Philadelphia." In 1984, CCAGP was established as a parent organization and the school name was changed to "MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL". In 2001, Ming De and Ding Hao divisions were established, each with a director. In 2002, the two sub-divisions under MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL became known as Ming De Main Line Chinese School and Ding Hao Main Line Chinese School.

Although in the CCGAP BY-LAWS, the definition of THE MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL has not been explicitly stated. The board hereby affirms the definition of THE MAINLINE CHINESE SCHOOL to constitute two sub divisions - Ming De Main Line Chinese School and Ding Hao Main Line Chinese School. The organization chart for CCAGP is also attached.
